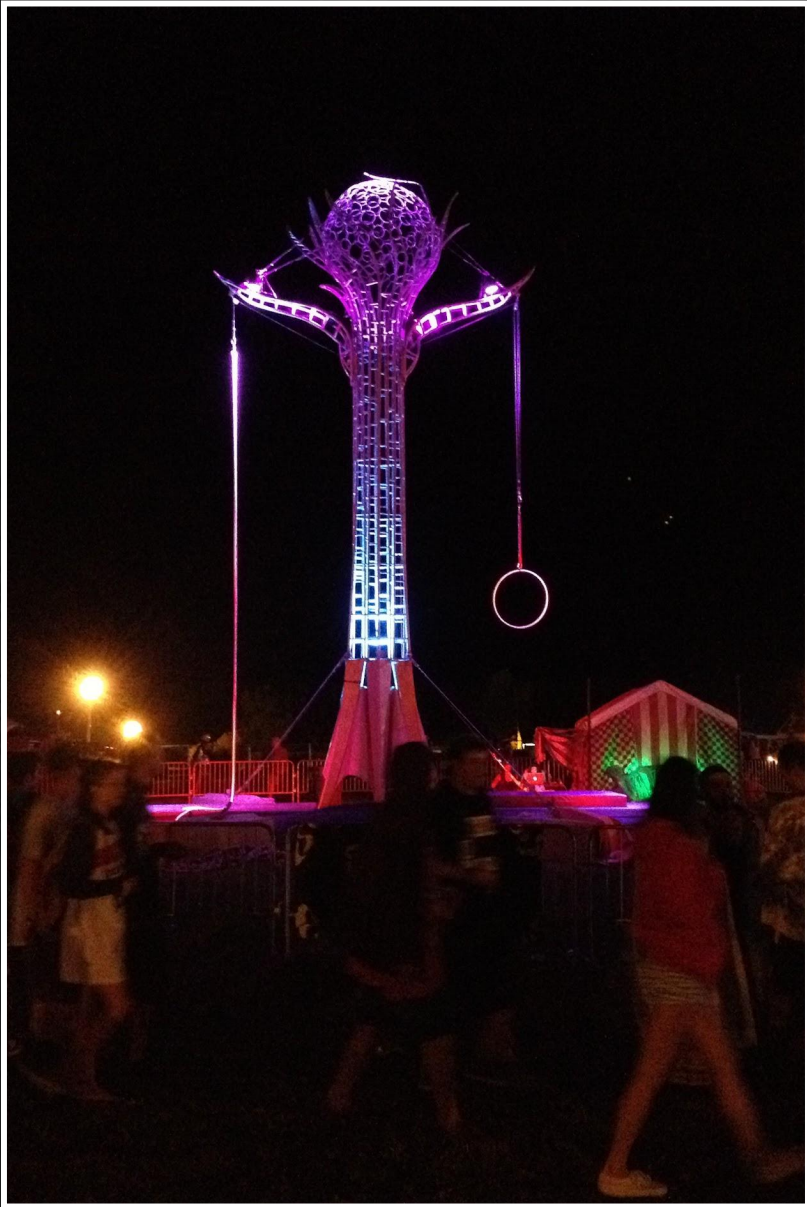


HISTORY

In 2006, Vau de Vire teamed up with large-scale metal sculpture artist Michael Christian in converting his 40' tall, free-standing sculpture into VdV's aerial playground, accommodating Aerial Art performances from the newly fabricated steel leaves 30' off the ground.

The sculpture has also been engineered to allow several to ascend Hypha's 30' stalk which at 40' opens into a 8' diameter bulb, perfect for viewing the earth from a bird's eye.

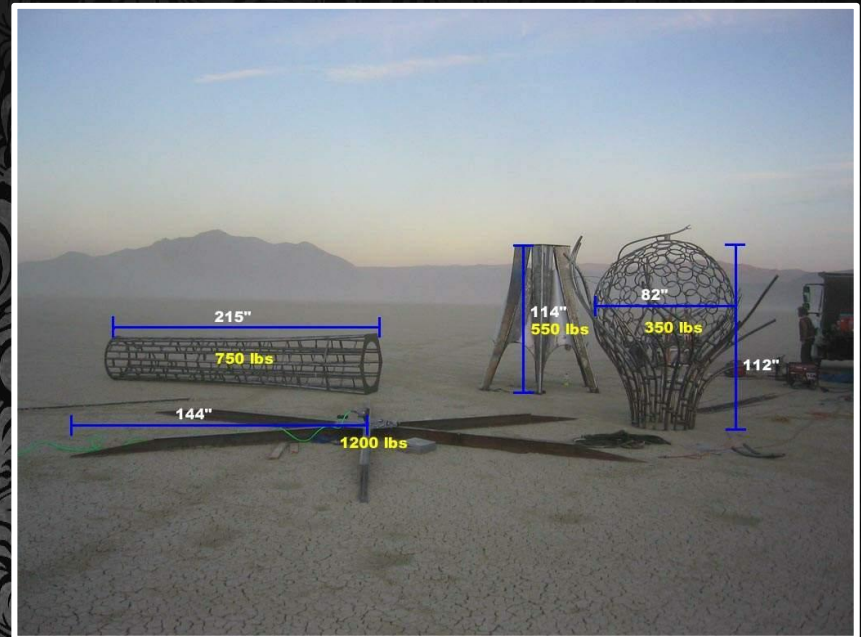




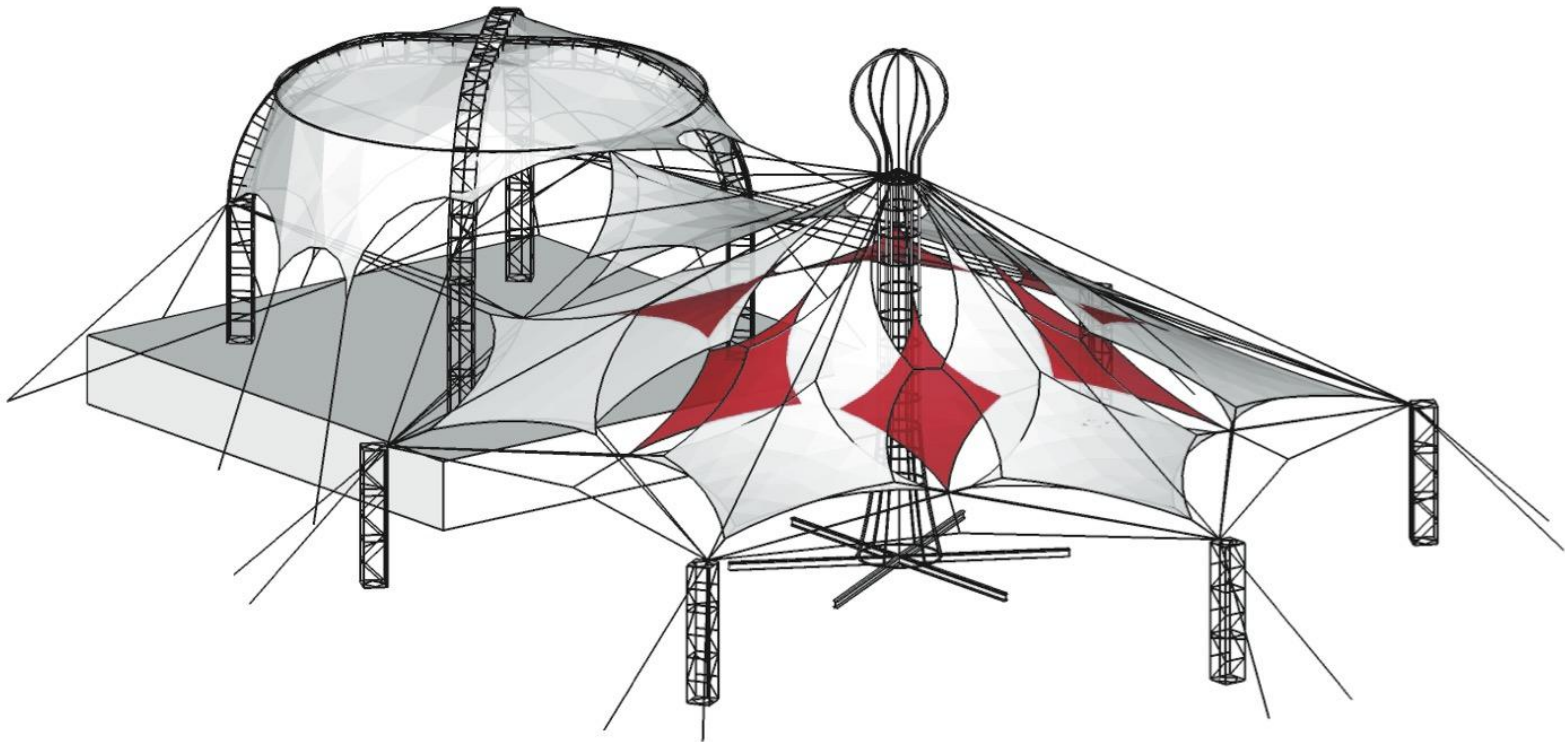
SPECS

The piece is broken up into four parts:

1. The top sphere. This piece is made of 1 and 1 ½ inch .065 tube steel. The smaller circles are ½ inch .065 tubing as well. The sphere shape is welded to a ring shaped piece of 5/16 plate steel. This piece is connected to the tower section with 18 grade 5 ½ inch bolts.
2. The tower section. This piece is constructed with 18 ft. long pieces of 2 inch .065 tubing with 1 ½ and 1 inch .065 cross members. Its top and bottom sections are 5/16 inch plate welded to the tubes and then bolted with ½ inch grade 5 bolts. The bottom section has 24 bolts connecting it to the base.
3. The base section. This structure is built with 18 10 ft long pieces of 2 inch .095 tubing welded together and then reinforced with 1 inch .065 cross members. It is covered with 18 gauge sheet metal. Each leg section is connected to a separate I beam with 4 grade 5 half inch bolts .
4. The I beam base. This section is made up of 6 12 ft long 6 x12.5 I beams connected at center by two 5/16 inch plate disc bolted together with 48 grade 5 ½ inch bolts.
